MOTOCROSS

The Chairman called for tonight's meeting to discuss the way forward - what protocols need to be put in place to ensure all Parish Council (PC) members are informed as they would like to be.

Cllr. Wain was nominated and he had agreed to be the spokesman for the PC to update the parishioners with the progress PC had on Motocross.

The PC would be responsible to lead any action against further Motocross planning going forward. The pledge for funding had reached over £15,000, the funds would be ring fenced for this project only. The record of donations and donors would be kept confidential. In the unlikely event of all funds raised not being required, it was agreed that contributors would be contacted at that time to determine what should happen to those residual funds.

The planning consultant fees would very much depend on the scope of the applicant's planning application and CDC's response.

The chair confirmed that the benefactor is a parishioner and would not benefit financially from the reduction or closure of the Motocross track.

The letter pledged funding was posted on the notice board and sent by email. There could be needs to hand deliver letters to those who didn't have access to emails.

The council would start the process of recruiting the new clerk after Christmas.

The council was made aware the possibility of the fuel depot could appeal against the planning decision.
